3301-34-02 Statement of Purpose

The purpose of the rules in this chapter is to prescribe conditions governing the issuance of excuses from school attendance under section 3321.04 of the Revised Code, to provide for the consistent application thereof throughout the state by superintendents, and to safeguard the primary right of parents to provide the education for their child(ren). Home education must be in accordance with law.

3301-34-03 Notification

4) Full name and birth date of child to be educated at home;
Assurance that home education will include the following, except that home education shall not be required to include any concept, topic, or practice that is in conflict with the sincerely held religious beliefs of the parent;
 (a) language, reading, spelling and writing; (b) geography, history of the United States and Ohio; and national, State, and local government; (c) mathematics; (d) science; (e) health;

(f) physical education;

(g) fine arts, including music; and(h) first aid, safety, and fire prevention.
